



Here's how you can take action to support our public schools, families, and students!

- Call your state legislators to support **S.308**, "An Act Strengthening and Investing in our Education Communities." Lead sponsors are Senator Michael Rush (Boston) and Representative Marjorie Decker (Cambridge).
- Support the **Raise Up Massachusetts** campaign (www.raiseupma.org), including:
 - * Paid Family and Medical Leave (H2172 and S1048)
 - * A \$15 Minimum Wage (H2365 and S1004)
 - * Fair Share Amendment
- Ask your local **School Committee** to formally endorse legislation in support of public schools, families, and students.
- Organize a **House Party** to screen *Education, or* and to discuss current issues.
- Attend a **test-resistance meeting** at the MTA headquarters in Quincy (2 Heritage Drive) on March 26 from 10:00 am - 1:00 pm.
- Donate to support the work of the **ACLU** in stopping the school-to-prison pipeline.
